

**Meeting of the Executive Committee, IADPPNW
July 16, 1987, Metropole Hotel, Brighton, U.K.**

Presents: Representatives from India, Kenya, Japan, Poland, Morocco, Sweden, U.K., New Zealand, Argentina, U.S.A., U.S.S.R.

1. Letters will be sent to Mikhail Gorbachev and Ronald Reagan advising of the formation of IADPPNW. It was suggested that the text of the resolution that will come before the UIA Congress be included.

2. A sub-committee was formed consisting of Papachristou, Platonov, McIntosh, Thiberg to draft a resolution to come before the UIA Congress on Friday, July 17. Papachristou and Platonov will meet with the raconteur from U.K. this evening at 6 pm to review the proposed resolution.

3. Executive committee members and council members should have the support of an organization behind them. Each country represented should send a letter to the Secretariat granting accreditation to its representative within two months.

4. Stockholm, Sweden is the proposed location of the Secretariat. Mr. Thiberg stated that this is a definite possibility to be confirmed. Sweden will accept letters during the interim 2 months.

5. Papachristou and Platonov will write a joint letter, before departing tomorrow, to the organizations represented at the inaugural meeting on July 15 thanking them for their participation. They should be asked to officially recognize the newly formed IADPPNW.

7. Finances

Each country will be asked to make an initial contribution of \$100. The Executive Committee is aware of the need for a sliding scale dues structure based upon ability to pay. A sub-committee was formed to work out an equitable system of dues. Their recommendation will be forthcoming in 6 months.
